WELCOME TO THE NEW ZEALAND KENNEL CLUB PRO PLAN NATIONAL DOG SHOW 2004

We thank you for your entry and trust that you have a most enjoyable time. For those from out of town we welcome you to "Waitakere City - It's Amazing" and wish you safe travelling.

A separate reporting sheet by a separate mailing is issued for the Prelude Show.

This year the show is under the sponsorship of PRO PLAN and we are thrilled with their generosity and input. Our sponsors have gone out of their way to assist us in making this an event equal to the prestige that a NATIONAL event should attract. We are indebted to them for their sponsorship, and for the enthusiasm they have shown towards contributing to the New Zealand Kennel Club to ensure that the PRO PLAN National Dog Show will be a success.

DRESS AND BEHAVIOUR: The NZKC PRO PLAN National Dog Show is the showcase of the dog exhibition year and attracts media and public interest. We know that as exhibitors, you will recognise this and display a high standard of sportsmanship, dress and behaviour to match the occasion.

ENTRY NUMBERS: These are enclosed. In the case of jointly owned dogs the number may have been dispatched to the address of one of the other owners. If you have more than four dogs entered or obedience entries as well as breed entries your numbers may be dispatched in separate envelopes. You have separate numbers for every dog entered in breed classes, and each test in obedience. Only one number is issued for each dog entered in agility irrespective of the number of classes the dog is being run in.

AGILITY VENUE: The Agility venue will be an outdoor venue at The Waitakere Trusts Stadium, Waitakere City. Auckland.

PRELUDE NUMBERS: You will be issued with a different number in a separate mailing.

PARKING: Entry to the Car park is gained through entrances 4 and 3. Parking is always at a premium at this show. We ask you to be considerate and patient. Follow the directions of the marshals. Parking inside the grounds is \$5.00 for cars and \$5.00 for Trailers. Trailers must be removed from cars and parked where instructed. Campervans, RVs and Buses \$10-00. Limited space. No pre booking. Parking is on a first come first served basis and no reservations are available. The Car Park will not open before 6.30 am.

DISABLED PARKING: Any car displaying an official disabled sticker will be admitted to the car park and found an appropriate park even if the park is otherwise full. Normal parking fees will be payable.

STREET PARKING is limited and strictly policed. The Trust Stadium is situated in a commercial area and our neighbours have to work here whilst the show is in progress. Do not park on private property. Do not park illegally. If you do either of these things you will be TOWED AWAY.

ACCESS TO BUILDING: No exhibitor entry to the building will be available before 7.am. The car park opens at 6.30 am. Entry to the building is through entry C which is the roller doors on western side of the building or up the steps on the eastern side of the building if you are parked on that side.

OBEDIENCE TEAMS ENTRIES: These must be made with the Obedience Manager upon arrival. You can pre-enter these competitions. Entry forms are available from the New Zealand Kennel Club.

OBEDIENCE AND AGILITY COMPETITORS must report to the Obedience Manager and/or Agility Manager upon arrival. Failure to report could result in your dog being scratched. Competitors in both agility and obedience on Saturday must advise both managers of possible conflicts in running times. Competitors will be expected to present themselves for competition. No class will be delayed for competitors not present. Only the Obedience and Agility managers can alter the running order. This will only be done by prior arrangement and will only be done for good reason.

BREED JUDGING: It is the exhibitor's responsibility to present their dog(s) for judging. Only three calls will be given after which time a dog will be deemed scratched.

CRATES, TROLLEYS AND TABLES: The designated grooming area is part of the main hall, no crates, trolleys or tables in the assembly area. There will also be floor markings for crate and table positioning, please remain in these and keep access ways clear to adhere to OSH regulations.

CATALOGUES: Pre-ordered catalogues can be collected at the show. A limited supply will be available for sale at the show for \$15.00 for a full show catalogue or \$5.00 for a Group, Obedience or Agility section only.

FOULING: The building will be a NO FOULING area. All show officials will be empowered to impose instant fines of \$20.00 for all fouling - faecal deposits and urination - inside the building. Fouling and not cleaning up outside the building including doorways can also incur an instant fine. Fines are payable at the secretary's office before the conclusion of the show. Let's make this a clean show.

EXERCISE AREA: There will be several exercise areas around the grounds; at these areas there will be scoopers and bags for your use. All foulings are to be cleaned up by the handler at the time.

CATERING: Full catering including snack food and small meals will be available in the cafeteria and food outlets. Tea and coffee will be available adjacent to the grooming area.

BAR: A Bar will be operating at this show.

DOGS ON GRAND STANDS: Exhibitors are reminded that the grand stands are for people only. No dogs are allowed in the stands.

SECURITY OF VALUABLES: Thieves have operated at past National Dog Shows both inside and outside the building. Please ensure your vehicles are secured and under your control at all times. Do not leave valuables in the grooming area.

PHOTOGRAPHS: Best in Show and Reserve in Show winners will be required to remain at the conclusion of the show for photographs. All BEST OF BREED winners will be required to proceed to the photography stall for a photograph immediately after the award is made.

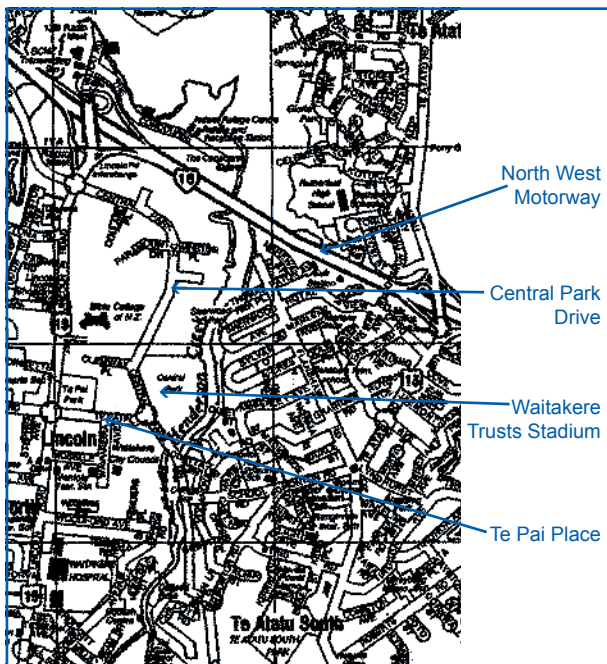
