



# NDTA 2009

## Agility Interclub Teams

Any club which is registered as an Agility Society with NZKC can enter up to two teams to compete for the trophy.

A team comprises of 3 handlers and dogs, with no more than two dogs eligible for the same classes in any one team – therefore teams may be made up of any of the following combinations (dog number does not represent running order):

No dog or handler can compete in more than one team.

The competition will be run over a separate Interclub Teams course which is scheduled for the afternoon of Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> October following the inter-zone Agility and Flygility competitions.

The course will be set and judged at Novice/Intermediate level but will not include a crossover or see-saw.

The winning team will be the team with the lowest cumulative faults in the fastest cumulative time.
