



NDTA 2009 Agility & Jumpers Finals Competition

Agility, B Jumpers & C Jumpers

There will be a minimum of 20 dogs in each final.

The first three dogs in each class will automatically qualify for the finals.

Each dog finishing in the first 20 places will receive points as follows:

1 st	20 points	11 th	10 points
2 nd	19 points	12 th	9 points
3 rd	18 points	13 th	8 points
4 th	17 points	14 th	7 points
5 th	16 points	15 th	6 points
6 th	15 points	16 th	5 points
7 th	14 points	17 th	4 points
8 th	13 points	18 th	3 points
9 th	12 points	19 th	2 points
10 th	11 points	20 th	1 point

The dogs with the highest points accumulated over the four Championship Agility classes or two Championship Jumpers classes will be listed and make up the remaining places, ensuring that there are at least 20 dogs in each of the finals. If a tie on points exists on the lower places all go through.

The running order of the finals competitions will be based on the highest scoring dog running last. The running order of dogs tied on scores will be decided on best places running later in the running order, then random if needed.

A Jumpers

There will be a minimum of 5 dogs in the final.

The winner of each A Jumpers class will automatically qualify for the finals.

Each dog finishing in the first 5 places will receive points as follows:

1 st	5 points
2 nd	4 points
3 rd	3 points
4 th	2 points
5 th	1 points

The dogs with the highest points accumulated over the two A Jumpers classes will be listed and make up the remaining places, ensuring that there are at least 5 dogs in the finals. If a tie on points exists on the lower places all go through.

The running order will be decided as for Agility and B & C Jumpers above.
