



NDTA 2009 Obedience Interclub Teams

The Interclub Teams Competition is open to dogs and handlers entered in Championship Obedience Tests at the NDTA on Saturday 24th October.

Any club which is registered as an Obedience Society with NZKC can enter a team to compete for the trophy.

A team comprises of 3 handlers and dogs, competing in 3 different tests on Saturday 24th October—i.e. Special Beginners 1, Novice 1, Test A1, Test B1, Test C1.

No dog or handler can compete in more than one team.

Every dog and handler entered must compete in every exercise in the test for which it is nominated for the team. If a dog is withdrawn from any part of the test the whole team is disqualified.

Points will be allocated to each handler according to their placing in the nominated test—i.e. First = 1 point; Second = 2 points, etc.

The points gained by each of the three handlers are added to form a team total and the winning team is the team with the lowest total points.

In the event of a tie, the team with the highest overall percentage of total points in each test will be the winner.
