

# The Sevens Challenge and National Show Announcement

As you are all aware the [2012 NZKC Eukanuba National Dog Show](#) is back at our own building in Porirua. Obviously to accommodate the National and the Sevens Challenge we are going to need more time which means a longer show. Having met with the clubs involved we have now come up with dates so you can all make your arrangements for accommodation and travel.

The [NZKC PRO PLAN Sevens Challenge](#) will run on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> October and Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> October. Four Groups will be judged on the Monday and three on the Tuesday along with [NZ Young Kennel Club](#) and the [Junior Dog Handler](#) final. The final of the Challenge will be judged on Tuesday. Monday and Tuesday evenings will be available for satellite shows.

An [Obedience Prelude Show](#) will also be held with a date to be advised.

The [NZKC Eukanuba National Dog Show](#) begins on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> October and runs through to Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> October. The show will run as it has in the past with judging running into the late afternoon/evening. Judges will be judging more dogs in a day than they have in the previous

couple of years. Satellite shows will be able to have some rings in the evening where available. There are several halls in the area available for hire as well. Many of you will remember using these for club shows in the past.

Charges for ring hire have yet to be set but you can be assured that entry fees and grooming area fees will be lower than last year.
